Types - Politically motivated - Art and literature - Subconscious anachronism. An out-of-place artifact (OOPArt) is an artifact of historical, archaeological, or paleontological interest found in an unusual context, that challenges conventional historical chronology by being too advanced for the level of civilization that existed at the time, or showing human presence before humans were known to exist. When something or someone appears outside of its proper time in a story, an anachronism has occurred. Anachronisms are abundant in movies and are.
