Mirabai's Poems. Mirabai's love for Krishna (called the Dark One in her poems) is the sole subject of her writing. She differs from other Bhakti in this way, as their god is less specific, but Mirabai was totally devoted to Krishna. Mirabai's Beliefs Mirabai was devoted to Krishna (as earlier explained Krishna is an incarnation of Vishnu). She felt that the best way to worship him was to love him as a romantic lover. She believed that Krishna was her only true husband and her poetry refers to him as My Dark Lord. .
